## MCC – MULTI CREW CO-OPERATION COURSE (MCC)

The aim of the course is to become proficient in multi-crew co-operation (MCC) in order to operate safely multi-pilot multi-engine airplanes. The objectives of MCC training are optimum decision making, communication, allocation of tasks, mutual supervision, use of checklists, teamwork, and support throughout all phases of flight under normal, abnormal and emergency conditions. The training emphasises the development of non-technical skills applicable to working in a multi-crew environment. This is achieved by training exercises in which the students are crewmembers in the pilot flying (PF) and pilot not flying (PNF) roles.

This short course takes 9 days to complete, and consists of both ground and simulator training teaching you the fundamentals of sharing the workload with another pilot, in a flightdeck environment. You will be introduced to common SOPs that are found in most airlines. The ground training is 25 hours. You will then move into the state-of-the-art Alsim ALX jet simulator for 20 hours.
